

PARENT SUPPORT

Parents play a very important role in AWANA.

Encourage your child:

--by listening to him/her practice verses at home.

--by helping them understand the meaning of the verses.

--by bringing your child every week unless they are ill. (If your children are sick, please let them stay home for their own well-being and for the well-being of others.)

--by praying for your child and your child's leaders.

--by volunteering to help in AWANA.

--by volunteering to bring refreshments on special occasions.

GUIDELINES FOR CLUBBERS

—Wear AWANA uniform each week.

—Bring a Bible and AWANA handbook.

—Be on time (5:30 pm).

—Have parents ready to receive you at 7:00 pm.

—Do NOT talk when leaders are talking, teaching, or giving instructions.

—No running in church except when permitted at game time.

—Always follow the instructions and directions of your leaders.

—No food or drink allowed except at special functions.

—Show proper respect for ALL church property.

—Pushing, shoving, roughhousing, hitting, cussing, and fighting are NOT permitted and will result in an automatic one-week suspension. Repeat offenders will result in a permanent suspension.

—When the “5” count starts for opening ceremony go straight to your color line and stand at attention.

—All Clubbers will remain in their handbook time
